Transcript



Q **LAURIE**

Q All of a sudden, the ship just went dead. Lights, engine, everything. The computers crashed; it was completely pitch black in the ops room, and you could hear a pin drop.

Q **BRIAN**

Q And there was no sound before that?

Q **LAURIE**

Q Nothing before that; and this wasn't the actual bomb hitting us, this was a bomb that flew across the fo'c'sle (forecastle) at the front of the ship, hit the water to the starboard side of the ship, and exploded. It was like the ship jumped out of the water and we were sitting ducks; and it seemed like forever that we had no power, no guns, no radar, nothing. But it was probably only in reality probably twenty thirty seconds. Then, probably half an hour later or so, we got the report that we'd been hit by a thousand pound bomb. And obviously we thought well it's a bit strange because we hadn't felt a thing.

Q You didn't notice anything?

Q **LAURIE**

Q Nothing, no. It had entered through the main magazine, come up into the loader and it had gone right through the steel doors which were probably an inch thick; smashed through these doors, smashed through some other steel bulkheads, and ended up in the aft toilets.

Q **BRIAN**

Q Of all the places a bomb could end up in.

Q **LAURIE**

Q That's where it ended up.





10 Point Plot Outline



1. HMS Antrim is sailing in the waters of San Carlos Water.
2. Argentine A-4 Skyhawks aircraft fly overhead.
3. A bomb is dropped from one of the A-4 bombers which narrowly misses HMS Antrim.
4. The bomb explodes in the water nearby to the right side of the ship.
5. The computers crash and the ship is plunged into darkness.
6. A second bomb is dropped by the A-4 bombers unbeknown to the crew on-board HMS Antrim.
7. It hits the ship, entering it through the main magazine and coming up into the loader.
8. The bomb proceeds to smash through some steel doors that are an inch thick and through some other steel bulkheads.
9. The bomb eventually ends up coming to a rest in the aft toilets where it fails to detonate.
10. The crew get the report that they have been hit by a 1000 lbs bomb half an hour later.
